Lice crawl from head to head when children are in close, physical contact with each other.

Head lice can spread by sharing hats, combs, brushes, or other items.

Head lice are not caused by poor hygiene or an unclean home.

Head lice do not spread disease.

Head lice are more common during the warm, summer months.

Consult a doctor or pharmacist before choosing any head lice treatment.

Do not use any over-the-counter head lice medication on children under 2 years of age.
